SUBJECT: Arrest Made in "Prowler Cases"

As a result of the cooperative efforts between citizens and the police, a subject was arrested by The Colony Police and has confessed to going into homes located on Tucson, Sunrise, and Wexley. All of the aforementioned locations are within "The Legends" area of The Colony.

Anthony Huynh (17), of The Colony, turned himself in to The Colony Police for an outstanding warrant, stemming from an incident at The Colony High School. The Colony Police Criminal Investigation Division had received numerous tips about the recent incidents of an individual entering homes, through unlocked doors, and fleeing upon being discovered. The citizen's tips generated leads that allowed detectives to gather evidence that Mr. Huynh committed some of the acts. After Mr. Huynh's arrest on 02/11/2012, he cooperated with detectives and has confessed to at least three of those incidents.

The Colony Police are still investigating and are determining the exact charges to file. Detectives have discovered that other individuals are aware of Mr. Huynh's activities, and either failed to report it to police and/or actually assisted in commission of the acts. Those individuals are strongly encouraged to come forward and explain their actions before possible charges are levied against them as well.

Mr. Huynh stated to detectives that he never intended to harm anyone and substance abuse and addiction to those substances were the contributing factors for his behavior.
