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TRAFFIC ADVISORY

SAM RAYBURN TOLLWAY/DALLAS NORTH TOLLWAY INTERCHANGE:

Both directions of the DNT and Headquarters Drive near the SRT to be closed overnight this Friday, Saturday and Sunday

Ongoing bridge work at the SRT/DNT interchange will necessitate the following overnight closures this weekend for the safety of the traveling public.

Crews will, however, re-open the closure areas during the day on Saturday and Sunday to improve traffic flow around the SRT/DNT interchange and the construction area.

From 11 p.m. Friday (Aug. 26) until 7 a.m. Saturday (Aug. 27); from 11 p.m. Saturday until 7 a.m. Sunday (Aug. 28); and from 9 p.m. Sunday until 5 a.m. Monday (Aug. 29):

- All northbound DNT main lanes will be closed between Headquarters Drive in Plano and just south of Gaylord Parkway in Frisco, to include the northbound DNT entrance ramp from Headquarters Drive.
- All southbound DNT main lanes will be closed between Warren Parkway in Frisco and Legacy Drive in Plano.
- The southbound DNT entrance ramp north of Warren Parkway in Frisco will be closed.
- The southbound DNT exit to SRT/the SRT frontage road will be closed.
- East- and westbound Headquarters drive will be closed between the north- and southbound DNT frontage roads.

Detour routes (see attached map):

- Northbound DNT motorists will exit to Headquarters Drive and then use the DNT frontage road. To re-access the northbound DNT, motorists may use the entrance ramp at Gaylord Parkway.
- Southbound DNT motorists will exit at the ramp to Warren Parkway and then use the southbound DNT frontage road. To re-access the southbound DNT, motorists will use the entrance ramp south of Legacy Drive.
- East- and westbound traffic that would typically use Headquarters Drive should instead use Legacy Drive or Tennyson Parkway as alternate routes.

Delays are possible, and motorists are encouraged to avoid the closure area by using streets adjacent to the SRT/DNT interchange as alternate routes.

The contractor will place electronic message boards and detour route signs to inform motorists and guide them through the closures. All closures are subject to weather conditions and will be rescheduled if necessary.

The NTTA appreciates the public's patience during the ongoing interchange construction and reminds everyone to use extra precaution while driving through the work zones.
