SAM RAYBURN TOLLWAY/DALLAS NORTH TOLLWAY INTERCHANGE:

Portions of DNT, SRT main lanes to close this weekend

Construction work necessary to continue the progress on the SRT/DNT interchange will require the following closures overnight Friday and Saturday, as well as all day Sunday through early Monday. The closures are required for the safety of the traveling public.

From 11 p.m. Friday, Sept. 23, until 9 a.m. Saturday, Sept. 24, and again from 11 p.m. Saturday, Sept. 24, until 9 a.m. Sunday, Sept. 25:

- All northbound DNT main lanes between Headquarters Drive and Gaylord Parkway will be closed, including the northbound DNT entrance ramp at Headquarters Drive.
- All southbound DNT main lanes between Gaylord Parkway and Headquarters Drive will be closed.

From 9 a.m. Sunday, Sept. 25, until 5 a.m. Monday, Sept. 26:

- All northbound DNT main lanes between Headquarters Drive and Gaylord Parkway will be closed, including the northbound DNT entrance ramp at Headquarters Drive.
- All southwest-bound SRT main lanes between Parkwood Boulevard and Legacy Drive will be closed.

Detour routes (see attached):

- Northbound DNT motorists will exit at Headquarters Drive, stay on the northbound DNT frontage road, and re-enter northbound DNT via the entrance ramp at Gaylord Parkway.
- Southbound DNT motorists will exit at the SRT/SH 121 ramp just south of Gaylord Parkway, stay on the southbound DNT frontage road, and re-enter the southbound DNT via the entrance ramp at Headquarters Drive.
- Southwest-bound SRT motorists will exit at the DNT/Parkwood Boulevard ramp, stay on the SRT frontage road, and then re-enter southwest-bound SRT via the entrance ramp west of Legacy Drive.

Delays are expected, and motorists are encouraged to seek alternate routes by using streets adjacent to the SRT/DNT interchange.

The contractor will place electronic message boards and detour route signs to inform motorists and guide them through the closures. All closures are subject to weather conditions and will be rescheduled if necessary.

The NTTA appreciates the public's patience during the ongoing interchange construction and reminds everyone to use extra precaution while driving through the work zones.
